The SULTAN CITY COUNCIL will hear a presentation by the Snohomish County Sheriff's Department related to the financial impacts to the City's budget of replacing the current Sultan Police Department with county law enforcement under a 24/7 dedicated FTE model. Citizens will have the opportunity to make comments at this meeting, beginning at 6:00 PM.

The City has had ongoing discussions with the county Sheriff's Department since the beginning of 2007 to inform and guide interest expressed by the City Council in switching its law enforcement services from the Sultan Police Department to contracting with the County Sheriff.

This possible action has been discussed at several council meetings and in other venues, among them the January 30th town meeting, the February 10th council retreat, the March 15th town meeting, and other council meetings.

We urge all citizens interested in Sultan's future police services to attend the meeting to learn more and share your thoughts on the proposed change. The final decision on this issue is tentatively scheduled to be made by the City council in June.

**The time and location of this regularly-scheduled meeting have been changed to accommodate the potentially larger group of citizens who may wish to attend and comment. Although this council meeting is one of 24 calendar-year meetings, both the start time, content and format will vary slightly.
