

**Plng. Board Oct. 2, 2007 Meeting Re Fallgatter IX
Decision by Central Puget Sound Growth Mgt. Hearings Board**

Acting PB Chair George Schmidt: I need some clarification on some things tonight. We have this response from the Growth Management Hearings Board decision, and it's just too....glossed over, and appears to be a very cavalier position. Why are we -- I guess it's -- are we taking this serious enough? We've had very clear public comment over the course of this planning board on these exact issues. We had the city attorney involved. We had the consultant involved. Why are -- why are we not getting this right? And if we just gloss over it and say, "Oh, we need this, we need this," I think what I want to hear is...."Here's the Plan. And to the degree of which we need to do this work, here's the timetable it's gonna take." Because I don't want to go through -- the next time it goes, I want it to go through right, and it needs to be clear and done well. So how are we gonna do that? And all that other stuff, that whole list of things you gave, Rick, after talking about this, until we get this done, there's no point in even talking about that stuff. So what's the plan of getting this right? And what's the timetable?
